Course Description:

Workplace violence can significantly disrupt an organization's mission, as well as seriously impact employee morale and feelings of safety and security. - Identify three (3) forms of effective interaction
- Apply several communication choices
- Diffuse potentially aggressive and/or violent behavior

Enhanced coping skills resulting in effectively managed violent and/or aggressive behavior. These skills can help ensure a safe, and secure workplace.
